In the past, choices for tree surrounds in city development has been limited to iron tree grates, and various types of concrete pavers combined with loose aggregate.



Iron tree grates are expensive to purchase, and replace. Concrete pavers typically do not allow for much aeration and may lose a lot of their permeability over time. Also maintenance crews find that they cannot prevent the scattering of loose aggregate over surrounding surfaces.

There is now a third option. Xeripave pervious pavers work exceptionally well in areas where cities need tree grates that get water to the roots and keep air flowing, but are still a practical and trafficable surface. The pavers are safer for wheel chairs and those wearing high-heel shoes, they look very nice, and they are only 1/5 of the cost of the metal tree grates.

Xeripave can also be used to retrofit the area if you already have concrete pavers in place, and the porosity of those concrete pavers has become limited. Strategically place Xeripave into existing areas to help the trees flourish again!
